Requirements:

- Eligibility requirements for exhibitors in the open class beef show are outlined in the General Rules and General Rules & Regulations for Jr Open, Open, and Nursing Home Resident Division sections of the Oconto County Fair premium list.
- All health requirements must be met before the animals are entered. See Health Requirements Section of the fair premium list.
- Exhibitors must present documentation of current immunizations for distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, parainfluenza, parvo virus and rabies to the show superintendent at check in. Most recent vaccination must be not less than 30 days prior to show date.
- Females in season will be shown outdoors, separately, and then must be immediately removed from the fairgrounds.
- One class per dog.
- Each dog in Brace Class may have been shown in one other class.
- The Open Class Dog Obedience trials will be the Sunday preceding the Fair, immediately following the junior Fair Dog Obedience trials.
