On behalf of the Oconto County Fair Board and the Fairest of the Fair Committee, I would like to thank you for your interest in serving as the Oconto County Junior Fairest of the Fair! Serving as Junior Fairest is a wonderful and extremely rewarding experience. The contestant chosen as the Junior Fairest of the Fair will work closely with the Senior Fairest of the Fair to serve as hostesses of the 2017 Oconto County Fair and to promote the fair throughout the year by attending various community events.

2017 Contest Information & Requirements

- ❖ The judging will be held on **Sunday, April 2nd**, **2017** at the Gillett High School. The contestants will undergo individual interviews, group interviews, introduction, radio spot, impromptu questions and event announcement. The decision of the judges is final.
- **❖** The contestant must be 11-13 years old as of January 1st, 2017.
- The contest is open to individuals who have been a resident of Oconto County for at least one year prior to entry or are from a neighboring county and the majority of their school and fair activities are performed in Oconto County.
- ❖ All contestants should attend Contestant Development Day, date & time TBD.
- Contestants must have a sponsor who covers the sponsorship fee of \$50. The sponsor can be a business or an individual. The final page in this packet is an information sheet for your sponsor.
- ❖ The Junior Fairest of the Fair will receive a crown & sash immediately and \$100 cash award at the end of her reign once her duties are fulfilled. All contestants will receive a gift bag for participating.

Junior Fairest of the Fair Required Activities

If chosen as Junior Fairest of the Fair, that contestant will be expected to appear at several events throughout the year. Exceptions can be made, so we are open to discussing the schedule with you. Below is a list of activities that we require of our Junior Fairest.
